Tuition Fee Payment Options

We draw your attention to the three payment options offered by the school, being annual, termly and monthly for the 2021 academic year. The monthly option allows parents to pay fees on a monthly basis over a 11-month period from January to November, by way of a debit order facility. The annual fee option equates to a 5% discount on the termly fee option, so families are encouraged to take advantage of that and pay for the full year in advance, if feasible.

Payment Plan

Fees are payable based on the payment plan selected ahead of each academic year:

- Annual plan: payable by no later than 7 January 2021.
- Termly plan: payable no later than the first day of each and every term.
- Monthly plan: payable in advance by the fifth day of each month from January to November, inclusive. **Nova Pioneer will process monthly payments via debit order.**

We encourage annual and termly payments to be made via EFT or debit order, as payments made via cash deposits and card machines attract bank charges which will be passed onto the parent's account.

Levies

Please note that the Tuition Fees are not inclusive of levies. Our levies are based on costs from external service providers with whom we have actively negotiated, to keep increases to a minimum for 2021.

- **General Levy*:** The general levy includes ER24 emergency medical response, sports programme and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) programme development. The general levy for the year will be billed on your statement in January and is due at the beginning of the month with your January fees.

The general levy at Nova Pioneer Midrand also includes a contribution to transport between existing and new campuses for student activities. Safe transportation is important to us. We will be moving students between the campuses to build a sense of community between all our students. This would include a variety of activities ranging from sporting opportunities, arts and culture, leadership opportunities and community building initiatives.

- **Stationery:** This is NOT included and a stationery list will be provided and parents will need to procure these items themselves from their preferred supplier.
- **IT Levy:** The IT levy contributes towards the costs of Google Chromebooks and licencing for subject-specific software programmes for your child's learning requirements, as well as internet access throughout the year. The levy for the year will be included on your January statement and is payable in accordance with your payment plan - annual, termly or monthly.
- **Cambridge Assessment:** All Grade 6 students are assessed using the official Cambridge Assessment, to determine their readiness for Secondary School. The levy covers the cost that Nova Pioneer is charged for this by Cambridge International. The levy will be included on your January statement and is payable in accordance with your payment plan. Any variation in price due to exchange rate fluctuations will be billed prior to the assessment.

** The school reserves the right to re-allocate the general levy for new operational costs that may arise during the year due to disruption or for other valid reasons.*

#The IT Levy shown here represents a monthly payment option, but should you elect an annual or termly tuition payment option, the IT levy for the year will be levied to your account annually or termly, respectively.

Family Discount

The school offers parents a family discount. This discount will only be allocated to the tuition fee from the second child onwards.

- The following sibling discount is offered on tuition fees:
 - Child #1: 0% discount on tuition fees
 - Child #2: 5% discount on tuition fees
 - Child #3 and subsequent siblings: 10% discount on tuition fees
- Discounts are applicable to tuition fees only. The full general levy, IT levy, and notice deposit are still payable in full.

Referral Discount

The school offers all current Novaneer families a tuition discount of R3 500 (on their own child's fees) for each new student referral. This discount will only apply if the student referred is successfully admitted to the school and the parent is referenced on the new student's application form. This referral discount is only applicable to the first year of tuition fees. Where a successful referral is made by a family who has two children at the school, the discount will only be applied to the child in the lowest grade.

Notice & Top-Up Deposit



A once-off Notice Deposit is to be paid upon acceptance in order to secure the student's spot at the school. Should you not take up your position offered, an amount equal to the notice deposit will be forfeited. This amount is paid back to the family once the student leaves the school, provided a full term's notice is given and there are no outstanding fees by the time of leaving. When the student enters a new phase at the school (Grade 00 into Grade R; Grade 7 into Grade 8), a Top-Up Deposit will be required in order to bring the student's deposit in line with the phase deposit value.
