

Hola!

This is Kaypacha on the beach at Goa for another weekly Pele Report.

I'm just in the middle of a workshop here and I've got to knock this baby out. We're jumping on the bus heading into a market in town today. But it is beautiful out here on the beach on the Anahata Retreat Center. And, particularly because what?

Well, the Sun has gone into Sagittarius, yeah, baby! (\*laughing) The fiery Sun in fiery Sagittarius, it's totally great! The Moon is in Capricorn, taking care of business, getting it all together. She goes into Aquarius tomorrow, on Thursday, coming around to Pisces on Sunday and we're going

to have that 1<sup>st</sup> quarter square Moon, Sun/Moon. Sun in early Sagittarius, Moon in early Pisces, 4 degrees, 38 minutes.

So today what else is new and good? I think I mentioned it last week, Neptune is stationing and going direct. So that's still takes a long time. And Neptune just like stations and stations and stations, OMG!

The other thing that's happening tomorrow that's pretty big, Venus will come into the exact square with the Moon's Nodes. So that's just in the middle of Scorpio, she's transiting and she's going right by, in square to the North Node still in the middle of Leo, South Node still in the middle of Aquarius.

Other than that, what I'd like to talk to you a little bit about today is just that great biggie, yeah. Jupiter trine Neptune, that is what the mantra is about today. Jupiter in Scorpio trining Neptune in Pisces. Really kind of a different energy than what we've been getting in some other way, yeah. Because the thing is that Mars was square Pluto and now Mars is moving on and coming into an opposition with Uranus. So, on the one hand we've got the, 'my will,' of Mars, wanting things to be a certain way - getting challenged with Pluto and then Uranus. And then we've got the other hand, last week we had Venus trine Neptune, now we've got Jupiter trining Neptune. It's really something else.

Last but not least, before I try to find a place in the shade, I don't know how this is going to work or not work. But the mutual reception of Venus and Mars is something to really be discussed. Because, it's going on since November 7<sup>th</sup> and it's continuing until November 30<sup>th</sup>. A mutual reception is when Venus went into Scorpio which is ruled by Mars, and Mars is transiting through Libra which is ruled by Venus. This is where the planets are trying to take care of each other's business. Let's see how Mars takes care of Venus' business and Venus takes care of Mars' business.

Ok, the chances of me pulling this off without interruptions are like really, really slim. People walking up and down the beach – OMG! (\*laughing) Going to have to be social with Mars in Libra. (\*laughing) But anyway, I am going to try to keep this light, even though by Monday, Mercury is exactly conjunct Saturn. And we've got this Saturn on the Galactic Center, it's pretty sober. Mercury coming into Saturn, sober again. Saturn approaching Capricorn, Black Moon Lilith in Capricorn, pretty sober. It's kind of a sober time.

When you look at Jupiter in Scorpio, Scorpio is death, end, finished, gone, over, annihilated, demolished, Shiva, it's like, death, it's over. Jupiter comes through Scorpio and says, 'More, more, more.' Let go of more. Shed this skin and shed another skin and shed another skin. And get out of this and get out of that and get out of the other – whoa, yeah! It's not always an easy time.

I want to look at this Venus/Mars because with the mutual reception, what they say is, a mutual reception in the old astrology books, not a real good thing. You can even look at it in your natal

chart. It causes problems, it doesn't cause problems, it indicates that you have problems. (\*laughing) The planets don't do anything to us, they reflect what we are and who we are and what we chose, in this and other lifetimes.

It says with Venus and Mars, you have trouble with 1<sup>st</sup> house and 7<sup>th</sup> house – 1<sup>st</sup> house is ruled by Mars, 7<sup>th</sup> house is ruled by Venus, self and other. My desires versus what other people desire. So, this creates what? Conflict in relationships, Venus/Mars, big time - 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> house. Venus rules the 2<sup>nd</sup> house and in old astrology, before Pluto, Mars ruled the 8<sup>th</sup>. So, it's bad news for 2<sup>nd</sup> house and 8<sup>th</sup> house matters.

Basically, the whole month of November, with Venus and Mars in mutual reception, it's saying that we've all got relationship issues coming up. And we've all got, 'What I want and what you want.' Needing to be clashed and discussed, to be worked on, to be looked at in order to some kind of resolution can happen. Or the other thing is conflict. There is winning and losing, when it comes to the 8<sup>th</sup> house. So, this can be a time when you lose. Or this can be a time of what? It's 1<sup>st</sup> house, it's competition, assertion, like, 'I want to win.' It can also be, where we want to win. And we get attached to a desire to some money, to some person, to some relationship, to something that we really want, that we really feel we need or we can't live without it and it's not easy, it's not working. The other is not cooperating. It's like, life is turning against us and we're having to wrestle when we really don't want to wrestle.

The Jupiter trine Neptune and that's what this mantra is all about, the unconscious forces. Venus and Mars are the personal planets and the personal planets are conscious. So, we become conscious of our feminine side. We become conscious of our masculine side. Our masculine side is what we want, we become aware of ourselves, through our desires and our wants. Venus is pleasure, it's this earth, my body, my sexuality, my money, it's earthly love, earthy pleasure. So, it's like, 'I want my comfort and cozy comforts' - Taurus, 2<sup>nd</sup> house, Libra, beautiful jewelry, everything with the 7<sup>th</sup> house. 'And I want a beautiful partner and I want a hassle-free partnership, no hassles. I just want them to be what I want and I will be everything they want. But, they have to be everything I want first.' (\*laughing) Isn't that always the catch? (\*laughing) 'As soon as you are everything I want, I will be what you want.' There's this whole dance with relationship and partnerships. It's like, you back off and if you're not getting what you want, you back off. Then the other person says, 'Oh.' And they come to you and there's this temporary, 'Oh yeah.' And then, you go forward and you go towards them. And they're feeling overwhelmed, or tired and they back off. And there's this whole kind of Yin and Yang, together and separate, night and day, sunrise and sunset.

But, we want to get to the bottom of this. This is astrology for the soul and let's be clear about it. The soul is unconscious. It is my own unconscious. It is the collective unconscious. It is source in the end and that is really designing the evolutionary process. And it's our egos that are trying to make sense out of it and trying to be comfortable and trying to get what the ego wants, in all this kind of very limited box. We all live in a limited box. What we believe. What we know. What we really understand is super limited. So, our choices are super limited by the

shortness of our scope. We only see a small portion of the spectrum. So, we only choose out of that little portion. You can't choose what you're not aware of, what you're unconscious of, what you don't see.

So, Uranus, our personal unconscious, Mars is coming up to oppose Uranus now, so this is going to get stronger and stronger. It's not until next week, I'll talk about it more. But our personal unconscious, Uranus, wants us to expand and grow and see more of that spectrum. So, what does it do? It throws us a curve ball. Something bizarre, something unusual, something unexpected. Our partners says this or does that, or the boss or the newspaper, or the bar, wherever you are. There's like some new trip, some new change, that you're like scratching your head going, what? What do you want? What now? What next? It's kind of irritable. It's kind of, you know what? I don't want to deal with another problem. Sometimes it's kind of hard to see how life is supporting us through change, through surprises, through even loss. It's like, you lose something and you think you really needed it. And you don't realize it until twenty years later, thank God, I lost that. So, it's a really strange situation.

And this is the beauty of Mercury conjunct Saturn. Saturn/Mercury, deep reflection, looking through the surface. Reflecting on why, especially Sagittarius, why did they say that? Why did they do that? Why is this happening to me? And by asking this inner question, what is spirit trying to tell me? What is my soul truly longing for? Obviously, this is pushing my buttons for an evolutionary growth process. This is the Jupiter trine Neptune. This is Neptune in Pisces. Pisces is infinite spirit. Neptune is channeling this infinite spiritual energy. So, it's faith and hope that's there's a bigger plan, a bigger picture, that is just not all chaos. That there is a source that has an intention, that is for our own good behind it all.

So, even when a bunch of people come into the Pele Report, I have to believe it was destiny. (\*laughing) So, let me wrap it up here, yeah.

The Manta for today goes:

As evolutionary astrology says, Jeffrey Wolf Green, my teacher says, we live in a polarized, dualistic reality. The soul has co-existing dual desires. The desire to separate from the source and the desire to return to the source. Like the wave upon the sea, we desire to separate. Go into Cancer and Leo, myself, my glory, my splendor, my original contribution. But, ultimately, we burn, we die, and we return back to the source that created us. What is your conscious intention? Where are you right now? All your choices, all your decisions, boil down to one or the other. Are you trying to separate? You want to do your own thing and be yourself and just like, me, me, me, build up that unique self. Or are you an older soul that's ready to return? I

am ready to return to the source that created me. And I am ready to surrender, allow, except and love. That's where she kind of boils down to, yeah.
