

Hola, Everybody!

This is Kaypacha with the weekly Pele Report. This is a special Pele Report honoring today's Super Moon Total Lunar Eclipse. You've got to be feeling the energy. If you're alive and you're not totally numbed out by now, okay, it's electric, Aquarius ruled by Uranus, the nervous system. Wow! The Super Moon is when the Moon is like so close to the Earth and it appears bigger than ever. It's a Blue Moon, it's the second Moon in the month, that's why they call it a Blue Moon - and then it is a total Eclipse.

The Solar Eclipse coming around in a couple of weeks from now is not a Total Solar Eclipse. It has to be really close to the Moon's Nodes in order to be a total Eclipse. And this Moon is so close to her North Node, it's at 11 degrees, 37 minutes of Leo. And the Node is up there at 13 or 14 degrees, it's only like 3 or 4 degrees away from being exactly on the Nodal axis. And what's opposite it?

Venus. Moon is not only opposite the Sun for a full Moon and a Total Lunar Eclipse, but Venus is also there. So, in a few hours after the eclipse, boom, the eclipse was just one hour ago and it's still happening right now, because it just doesn't happen in a couple of minutes.

So, that's what's going on and not only that, but what? We got a full Moon in Leo, the lion, the lioness opposite the Sun and Venus. Today, Mercury goes into Aquarius. So, we've got the

South Node of the Moon, Venus, the Sun and Mercury all over there in Aquarius holding out against the Moon (*laughing), no, they're all working together, the planets are always working together. They're both, all of them, in square to the biggest planet in our Solar System, Jupiter! Jupiter is almost big enough to be a star, did you know that? If a certain thing happened and it collapse on itself or whatever, it could become its own star.

I'm going to be doing something a little different for today. It's going to be a long Pele Report, but it's just not a Pele Report. I've had some people ask not just to be talking about this stuff, but to bring in some practices. So, after I am done talking at you, I'm going to bring you a Kundalini Yoga breathing exercise, thanks to Kal who emailed it to me. That is all about strengthens and energizing ourselves, releasing toxins, purifying and purging. It gives us more energy, it helps to center ourselves and ground ourselves. Because this is especially what we need at this time. Leo is a fire sign and Aquarius is an air sign, or an outer space sign and it's just like, up, up, boom!

I'm going to be talking for quite some time today because we really want to look at this powerful time. The Total Eclipse is bringing up issues, it is bringing up awareness. It is bringing up opportunities for evolution and growth, not just for this week, not just for this month, but for our entire lifespan and the next 2,000 years of the Age of Aquarius. We are on the tipping point, we are on the verge, we are at the dawn of this Age of Aquarius, that last for 2,000 years. We are emerging out of the Age of Pisces that has lasted for 2,000 years. It's almost like if you know a new born, not a new born baby, but around one year old, they start to walk and that's kind of what we're doing. (*laughing) We're coming out of this age of innocence, naivety, follow the Priest, Rabbi, Guru, whoever, just do what you're told and blah, blah, kind of sleep walking (*laughing) for a couple thousands of years. We're waking up now and trying to stand on our own two feet and walk and it's like we're going to fall down, we're going to fall down. We're going to fall back and we're going to fall forward and fall sideways. Sometimes we'll pick ourselves up. Sometimes we need each other to pick ourselves up.

I especially want to thank my amazing, wonderful wife, Laura, for bringing in so much of the content for today's Pele Report! Because this is the axis and part of this coming into this Age of Aquarius is dealing with the paradox. The paradox of the Leo/Aquarius axis is independence and interdependence, between being individual and between being a community. Between being self-engrossed, narcissistically oriented, egotistical. 'I am it. I am the star. I am the amazing King or Queen of planet Earth.' Versus and opposition to but co-existing with community.

So, she sent me this little thing today and I'm going to read it to you in a little bit. This is from the "Center for Healthy Sex." They send out a daily mediation, we belong to this thing. I'm going to put a link for in it the notes. If you want to sign up for this Center, these meditations are frickin' outrageous. <http://centerforhealthysex.com/>

First, I think I want to read... let's look at the past. Let's look at this Sun/Mercury/South Node/Venus all up here in the sign of Aquarius. Aquarius is where there's a couple of things going on and I've talked about rebel, revolt, step outside of the consensus, of the norm and create seedpods. Create new communities, new families, new ways of not being codependent, but not being independent, but being interdependent. This is the trick, this is what we're moving into. It's doing community, doing society in a new way. That's not about patriarchal, hierarchical, domination and control of the masses through fear, greed or whatever. But really coming into a place where unity and in diversity.

So, we need to be individuals. We need to be this Leo and we need to find ourselves and find our core. And, we also need not to get stuck there. We need to be open to listening, to receiving feedback and to really come into a place of cooperation, of understanding, and of creating a social dynamic.

Let's look at the Moon, the Moon has to do with our subconscious instinct, our inner child, our past and it's in Leo. So, here's our past, 'I want to be special. I want to be unique. I want everybody to see me. I want them to approve of me and love me, adore me. And omg, I just tah-dah!' (*laughing) I'm ready for Hollywood. I'm ready for the stage.'

These are these cards I got and I'm sorry, this wonderful woman just gave these decks of cards in Mexico and I'm so terrible, I forgot her name. It was years ago and if you're listening, send me the name of this deck and your name. I remember your face and your chart, but I don't remember names so well. But, listen to this. I just drew this card randomly last night as I'm going into the dream state, like wanting to get a mantra from source and this and that and the other. And I draw a card and let me dream about this. It comes out individuality, individuality. "With the shield carrier reaches the top of the mountain, she never seeks approval. Because approval is based on doubt. (You doubt yourself, 'Oh please, tell me I'm okay!') Your strength and wisdom are celebrated in your unique ability to view the experience of life with new vision. Power lies in individuality and the ability to see yourself through your own eyes, and not through the eyes of another. (Like, I know myself, thank you very much! I am in my witness, my observer. I am awakened. Thank you. I am an individual. I am self-aware. This is great power.) To be in power, you must take your power and exist within your own individuality."

So, this is a powerful way, this is the way of the lion, the lioness, this is the way of Leo. 'I am self-aware. I am an individual. No one can teach me or tell me how to be me. I have to discover it and express it and almost create myself out of myself, by being myself. I will know myself through my creations. When I create a song, a dance, a baby, a relationship, a house, whatever, I see myself through my creations.' This North Node of Moon and the Moon conjunct the North Node, is really going into this, 'You know what? Creative self-expression!'

But, Jeffrey Green, the founder of Evolutionary Astrology say's, "When there are planets conjunct the South Node of the Moon, it's unfinished business or a fruition of everything that has come in past lives." The Sun and Venus are both conjunct the South Node of the Moon in

Aquarius, we have some unfinished business to attend to. So, this unfinished business or this fruition, is about community, it's about interdependence. Not through blind sheep following a Shepard, but through being awoken individuals, ready, willing and able to enter society, relationship, cooperation, businesses – this all takes cooperation.

Now I want to read from the "Center of Healthy Sex." This daily mediation that I got this morning that Laura sent me. First is a quote from, Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi. "It is man's social nature which distinguishes him from the brute creation. If it is his privilege to be independent, it is equally his duty to be interdependent. Only an arrogant man will claim to be independent of everybody else and be self-contained." Talk about Aquarius leading the revolution against the English for all the people in India - it's like, hello!

Let's go on here with the daily mediation. *"When two beings depend on each other and interdependence occurs. That's fully natural, because as in all of nature, no single being can thrive alone. In interdependence, both parties are mutually reliant. While independence, one party leans entirely on the other. A period of dependence may be crucial for children, puppies, kittens and other young to survive. But interdependence, is an equally crucial adult development tasks. It's essential not for just a couple, but for larger entities as well. For a family, a business, for human society and for our Earth. By tending to your lover, family, neighbors and the living Earth, you're ultimately attending to your own garden." I like it.*

*"Homeostasis, the balancing wisdom of the body. Is key to all healthy interdependence systems, including relationships. It keeps the system equilibrium, much as healthy bodies keep a proper temperature. Because attachment is so central in our development, we can describe a relationship as though it were physical body, with vital organs and points of vulnerability. When one of these points is injured, say the trust organ or the respect organ, the entire system (relationship) may shut down. Robust systems, relational or physical, correct themselves through both positive and negative feedback." I know that one, it's when you eat something bad, your stomach gives you negative feedback. When you're really messed up in the head, you get a headache. (*laughing)*

"Negative feedback tends to balance systems and positive feedback, tends to grow them stronger. When something is wrong in a relational system, negative systems usually grab our attention and call us to reparative action. In a relationship, that's the time to own your part in the problem, by admitting your challenges to your partner. But don't forget, that it's equally important to build on what's going well, to take time to celebrate moments of joy. For interdependence works only with each member full participation in the health of the system.

You get this? For a healthy relationship, for a healthy business, for a healthy community, for a healthy society, for a healthy planet, we have to acknowledge the interdependence of all creation. This is where we are all one and where we are all one really hits the road. We do need each other, just like we need the plants, the animals, the oxygen and the Earth. To deny our interdependence, is to be foolish, to be naïve and to ultimately not survive.

So, this need for connection is not just a spiritual need, we are physically... there's a food chain, by God, it's like, 'Hello, Man!' There is this interdependence happening. And yet, as Leo will say, each and every single one of us is special and creative and unique. And we need to bring our own brilliance to the stage, to the light, to the community. And we need to go inside and really not become codependent, but interdependent. So, there is this process of maturing that got to happen.

And now what I can also say is, you can also see this in the cycle of any given lifespan, in any given cycle, the cycle of the Moon, we are now at a full Moon – this is the turning point. Aries, Taurus, Gemini, Cancer, Leo, Virgo, this is out. This is, I am the plant from springtime, Aries, new impulse, the seed grows and gets stronger and is bigger, opens up and bares fruit. And then Virgo is the harvest of that fruit. 'Thank you very much. The community needs these cashews. The community needs these avocados. The community needs these mangos, coconuts, whatever.' It's like, the plant gives, this is the harvest of Virgo.

And from Libra, Scorpio, Sagittarius Capricorn, Aquarius, Pisces, guess what? The outside forces of relationship, of partnership, of the bigger, wider, greater cosmic reality, grows stronger and stronger and it's like, 'Whoa, baby! You better merge.' The planet withers, dies and gives off it's seeds. And then comes winter, the needs of the many outweigh the needs of the few.

This Aquarius time is a time when the needs of the community, the needs of society, the needs of the country, the needs of Mother Earth are more important than our own personal show. (*laughing) We have to kind of open ourselves, that's what the mantra this week is about. We are ready for union. This is a willingness, this is a choice, this is a decision. 'I'm really going to offer my fruit to the community. Not for approval, and not for attention and not for money and love, not so I can be bigger. But no, I'm going to serve, sacrifice, give, release for the good of the all. And knowing as I give to the whole, the whole is going to support me, help me to survive and give back to me. This is where Pisces and faith and hope really comes in very powerful and very strong! You see what I'm saying?

The Mantra for this week is:

***It's hard for me to lay myself out,
Both my future and my past,
Not seeking approval or longing for love,
But ready for union at last.***

I want to get into the square of Jupiter in Scorpio. It's going on this whole eclipse time season. Next week, Venus squares Jupiter. Then the Sun comes around and squares Jupiter. We've got this whole Venus/Sun/Jupiter square, and right now we have the Moon square Jupiter. Next week I'll talk about the 3rd quarter Moon, she's conjunct Jupiter.

This Jupiter in Scorpio is saying that there are great rewards, great abundance, great fruits to be received through, Scorpio, 8th houses, union, merging. Sometimes it's humbling, sometimes we

need to take feedback that's negative feedback to balance ourselves and admit that we're wrong. Lay out my past and you know what? 'I am a struggling human being. Forgive me, I messed up. I've made an error, blah, blah, blah.' It takes guts to like admit that sometimes we blew it, made a mistake, whatever.

This vulnerability, this exposure, Scorpio in the 8th house has to do with Psychotherapy. They have to do Shamanism, it has to do with sex, vulnerability has to do with opening up. When we hide and keep secrets, it creates division and it put wedges in our relationships, it puts walls between us. Jupiter is saying, tear down these walls. Get humble, look stupid. But, there's nothing better than makeup sex. (*laughing) It's like, 'I blew it. I hurt you. You're a jerk.' You do your whole intense Scorpionic jealousy, envy and anger and passion. And then it's like, 'Oh, but you know what? Even though you're an idiot, I love you!' (*laughing) And then of course, there's great union, great time.

This Jupiter in Scorpio it promise's, there is a promise here of great expansion, of great opportunity through really doing our work. This is just a time period where you could be really torn. Because I could say the downside or the outside, the challenge with Aquarius and the Sun/Venus and Mercury, like I talked about before. Is, isolating, withdrawing. 'I don't belong on this planet. I'm an alien. I'm so different and weird, nobody will understand me. I'm not going to come off my mountain top and expose myself and admit that I'm a human being and that I have emotions, needs and fears. No, no, no. I'm going to be above it, outside it, beyond it. Forget society. Forget community.' It's the ultra-extreme of individualism. Leo wants to be an individual, but wants to have an audience at least. If Aquarius goes too far out there, they don't want an audience, they don't want anybody, they don't want anything, they are withdrawing from. What did Gandhi say? "It is equally crucial adult developmental task." Interdependence. It's a good thing that we've got 2,000 years to learn this – this is the Age of Aquarius. And we're just models and examples, pioneers and we're just learning how do this interdependence. And we're going to go too far either way. We'll go into codependence, we'll go into pure interdependence. Take it easy on yourself, man.
