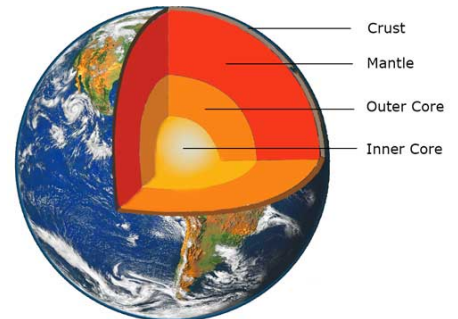


MATH

We started off by using manipulatives to understand and represent problems which involved multiplication. We then moved on to using the standard algorithm to solve longer and complex multiplications.
