ENGLISH

In Phonics this month we have revised the letter sounds Z, W and V. We discovered new digraphs, 'ng' and 'oo'. As a class we found new words with these sounds and wrote our own sentences using these words. We learnt about how we can use conjunctions to join sentences together and are increasing our vocabulary with suffixes and prefixes. It has been interesting listening to stories written by various authors and comparing and discussing our favourites.

MATHS

We have enjoyed the activities completed in Maths this month. Particularly completing bar graphs on pets and bugs. It was fun to answer questions about the information we gathered on these topics. Fractions are fun! We are able to color parts of a shape and write the fraction to match.

SCIENCE

Topic of the month-Day and Night

This unit started with the concept of Earth and how it rotates on its own axis. We then focused on the sun and shadows. We also learnt about how the movement of the sun makes shadows longer and shorter. We also had a brief introduction to our solar system.

SOCIAL STUDIES

Topic of the month- Landforms

In this unit we learnt about what a landform is and looked at different types of landforms. We are able to identify and name these: Mountain, Hill, Valley, Volcano, Plateau, Plain, Lake, River, Pond, Island, Desert and Isthmus.
